CRD Facilities: Do you support financial participation by the District of Central Saanich in a renovation/expansion of the Panorama Recreation Centre that provides a new swimming pool, financed by Capital Region debt totaling \$8.998 million that will increase annual residential property taxes in Central Saanich by approximately \$8.50 per \$100,000 of assessed property value (\$44.31 annually per household, on average) over 15 years?
