b) Verbal Update from the Superintendent of Public Works Regarding Appropriate Signage With Respect to this Matter

The Superintendent of Public Works provided information concerning public awareness initiatives that would be undertaken by Staff, and recommended that public awareness signs, similar to those used by the Capital Regional District and Saanich, be installed at the following locations;

- Municipal Hall
- Centennial Park
- Ron Knott / Pioneer
- Rodolph Park
- Chatterton Park

The Administrator advised that the installation of the signage could be undertaken within the current budget.

The members of Council concurred with the recommendation to install public awareness signage at the above locations.

A member of Council inquired as to whether Staff considered the use of public awareness stickers applied to District vehicles, as this was a good way to get the message out. The Superintendent confirmed that Staff could follow up on the potential use of such stickers.
