1. Introduction of Consultants for Truck Route Bylaw Project

The Administrator, Gary C. Nason, introduced the consultants Mr. Gerard LeBlanc and Mr. Jason Jardine.

Mr. Gerard LeBlanc, Landworks Consulting Inc., advised the District's website should be utilized to assist in releasing public information. He overviewed the notifications for the Open Houses, and how the consultants will work with Staff and the public. He responded to questions from the Committee.

Mr. Jason Jardine, Delcan, overviewed the study objectives, the Open Houses on October 11 and November 15, and the presentation of the final report on December 10. He overviewed why a truck route is needed as well as the criteria in selecting a route.

A discussion occurred between the Committee and Staff and the consultants responded to questions.

Councillor Thompson requested Staff explore the cost of renting a public notice sign similar to the one utilized by the Saanich Fair and Camosun College to be placed in the Keating Industrial Area to announce Open Houses etcetera.

Mr. John Senyk, 2277 Lynne Lane, raised concerns in the previous study and questioned how they would be addressed for the current review process. He further inquired how much public input was provided for the previous study.

The Consultants and Staff advised the previous study was related overall to transportation issues including truck routes, Mt. Newton, and bicycle lanes.

Mr. Senyk inquired if all previous correspondence would be provided to the Consultants.

The Senior Engineering Technician, Roland Rocheleau, advised all correspondence received on this matter for the last five years has been forwarded to Delcan.
