**1. Updating and Redrafting of District's Traffic and Highways Regulation Bylaw and Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw**

- a) Staff Memorandum dated January 27, 2006 from Nirmal Bhattacharya, Municipal Engineer, and Ken Neurauter, Bylaw Enforcement Officer, entitled "Updating and Redrafting of District's Traffic and Highways Regulation Bylaw and Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw".

The Municipal Engineer, Mr. Nirmal Bhattacharya, provided a comprehensive overview of the Staff Memorandum in regards to the proposed updating and redrafting of the District's Traffic and Highways Regulation Bylaw, during which time he highlighted several major changes, as follows:

- Boulevard and Parking on Boulevards;
- Peace Officer;
- Meters and Wheel-Locks;
- Maintenance of Boulevards;
- Towing and Impoundment Fees;
- Vehicle Parking Restriction of 72 Hours;
- Mechanically Disabled Parking for 24 Hours;

He further noted that an amendment to the District's Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw would be required by deleting Schedule 9 in its entirety and substituting it with an updated Schedule (List of Offences, Sections and Fines) pertaining to the proposed Traffic and Highways Regulation Bylaw No. 1535.
