**1. Rom Knott Park Walkway Investigation**

- a) Staff Memorandum dated June 5, 2006 from Roland Rocheleau, Senior Engineering Technician Re: Rom Knott Park Walkway Investigation.

The Municipal Engineer, Mr. Nirmal Bhattacharya, provided an overview of the Staff Memorandum in regards to the proposed walkway to provide a pedestrian link to the Brentwood Village for the Sluggett Road residents, and advised that the related costs to undertake this work would be accommodated from the 2005 carry over funds.

The Chair opened the floor for comments from the public in attendance at the meeting.

Mrs. Braunda Gustafson, #304 – 1196 Sluggett Road, advised of her support for the proposed walkways which would provide a safe passage for pedestrians, particularly those with scooters and walkers.

- 1. a sidewalk and a pedestrian crosswalk at the intersection of Wallace Drive and Sluggett Road, as noted in Appendix C - Item 1 of the Memorandum;*
- 2. a sidewalk between the ball field and play area, as noted in Appendix C – Item 2 of the Memorandum; and*

*the 2005 carry over funds for the proposed sidewalk along Wallace Drive (Community Hall to Sluggett Road) be used to complete the recommended construction.*
