Pay Grade 38 \$29.19 per hour (Jan 2019 Rate) plus 13% in lieu of benefits

The District of Central Saanich invites applications from qualified individuals interested in providing temporary full-time, maintenance services in the Parks Maintenance Section.

Reporting directly to the District Parks Foreman, this position's responsibilities include:

1. Assist in and perform a variety of semi-skilled tasks in the parks maintenance, repair and construction of municipal parks infrastructure and associated works;
2. Operate the necessary municipal vehicles, tools and equipment to complete the assigned tasks;
3. Assist other municipal sections as required;
4. Perform all other related duties as required.

The successful candidate(s) will have the ability to perform common parks maintenance tasks and duties in a competent and safe manner, work independently with limited supervision, serve the public in a courteous manner, and establish and maintain good working relationships with his/her supervisor, other employees, and the general public. The incumbent must be physically fit and be able to work outside in all weather conditions.

Minimum Qualifications:

1. Completion of Grade 12 (or equivalent qualifications and experience);
2. One year relevant experience and previous experience in municipal parks operations, or equivalent training and experience acceptable to the employer, supplemented by work related courses;
3. A valid Class 5 BC Drivers Licence;
4. Knowledge and ability to comply with and follow all pertinent WorkSafeBC and Occupational Health and Safety regulations.

A valid Class 5 BC Driver's License with is required; however, a Class 5 BC Driver's License with air or Class 3 Licence is desirable.

The current wage for this position is Pay Grade 38 \$29.19 per hour (Jan 2019 rate), plus 13% in lieu of benefits. Except for unforeseen circumstances or budgetary shortfalls, the term of employment will be from approximately April 1, 2019 to July 26, 2019. The hours of work will be: 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. (8 hrs/day, with a 1/2 hour unpaid lunch break), Monday through Friday, unless otherwise directed by the Foreman.
