

Business Electric Vehicle (EV) Charger Grant

Central Saanich's Business EV Charging Grant offers up to 50% of the overall cost of installing a Level 2 charging station (max. \$5,000 grant per station) to local businesses seeking to add a public charger to their site. The owner of the property must match the contribution and applications will be assessed on a first-come-first-serve basis.





Are you eligible?

Existing businesses, not-for-profit organizations, and indigenous communities with businesses that provide a public service within the District of Central Saanich would be eligible, with written consent from the property owner.

Stations must be available for public use before, during and after business hours and remain accessible 24 hours per day, throughout the year. You may charge a cost related to the amount of time spent at the charging station by your customers, employees or the general public.

All projects during this intake period must be completed by December 31, 2023 to be eligible.
